Regular maintenance throughout the year will keep your boiler in tip-top shape. Here's a checklist you can go through to ensure everything is working correctly.

Check the boiler's pressure gauge to ensure it's within the recommended range (between 1-2 bars)	X		
Inspect the venting system for any blockage or obstruction.	X		
Listen for unusual noises or vibrations from the boiler while it's operating.	X		
Test the safety relief valve to ensure it's functioning correctly.		X	
Check the flue gas vent for signs of corrosion or leaks.		X	
Inspect the combustion chamber and burner for soot or debris.		X	
Clean or replace the boiler's air filter if applicable.			X
Lubricate any moving parts according to the manufacturer's instructions.			X
Inspect and clean the heat exchanger.			X
Check the condition of all gaskets and seals; replace if necessary.			X
Verify the thermostat is calibrated correctly and accurately.			X
Test the operation of all safety controls, including the pressure relief valve and high-limit control.			X
Schedule a professional boiler inspection and service.			X
